### Who Should Attend?

The course is suitable for any organisation or individual seeing the need for a controlled approach to managing its projects, including; Project Managers, Project Support, Team Members from any discipline. The PRINCE2 method is flexible and adaptable for any type and size of project. It offers an excellent management foundation for any member of staff; no prior Project Management knowledge is necessary.

### Benefits of Attending:

Following the course, delegates will be able to organise, plan and control projects quickly and effectively in accordance with the PRINCE2 Methodology. Senior management will be able to make decisions on project initiation and continuation on the basis of hard facts provided in a structured format. The course is represented in an interactive format with practical sessions, delivered by a trainer with considerable experience of PRINCE2. Practical sessions will be on an individual and team basis focusing on the Foundation Examination.

### Course Structure :

#### Pre-course Reading

There is some pre-course preparation requiring approximately 15 hours study. The material is supplied as a computer-based course which can be used on any PC with a web browser. Connection to the internet is not required. The pre-course material covers the differences between line management and project management followed by an overview of the PRINCE2 method. Self-

test material is included.

#### Overview

This course covers both PRINCE2 Foundation and Practitioner course covering 6 days, out of which first four days will cover Foundation course followed by Foundation examination on 4th day. Day 5 and 6 will cover the Practitioner course followed by Practitioner examination on 6th day. Formal training lasts from 9.00am - 6.00pm each day with home study and revision exercises. We provide detailed training material since the PRINCE2 manual is intended as a reference book and does not by itself provide a sound basis for studying the method. There is an integrated case study to provide a firm basis for discussion and understanding of the method.

#### Examinations

Sample examination questions are introduced throughout the course at an appropriate time. Candidates are encouraged to take the PRINCE2 Foundation and Practitioner examinations on the 4th and 7th day respectively immediately following the course.
